Dear Hiring Manager,

I am applying for the Entry Level .NET Developer position with Bluegrass Application Partners. I completed a Bachelor of Science in Computer Science in 2026 and have built C# and .NET applications through academic projects involving healthcare benefits, finance, and inventory management. I am interested in this role because it combines practical software development with the opportunity to learn from experienced professionals while supporting projects shaped by real business needs.

In my healthcare benefits capstone, I developed an ASP.NET prototype that translated 14 eligibility rules into reusable validation methods and documented workflows. I designed SQL Server tables and stored procedures for member, plan, and enrollment records, built HTML forms in Visual Studio, and tested cases such as expired coverage, missing dependents, and conflicting plan dates. I also used Excel to reconcile application results with sample benefit calculations, which helped identify exceptions before the final demonstration.

My other projects strengthened the habits I would bring to an entry-level development team: breaking work into testable methods, investigating defects in Visual Studio, writing parameterized SQL queries, and documenting setup steps and test results clearly. While managing several weekly lab assignments, I used a task tracker to meet deadlines without losing attention to validation or readable code. I would welcome the chance to contribute those skills at Bluegrass Application Partners and continue developing as a .NET professional.
