Owned feature planning, defect investigation, deployment documentation, and review preparation within a four-person delivery team. Work connected technical decisions with customer experience, maintainability, and release readiness.

- Built **Laravel** and PHP ecommerce workflows for catalog, cart, and orders with **MVC structure** and MySQL models, creating a maintainable product foundation.
- Implemented responsive **HTML**, CSS, JavaScript, and React checkout views, then tested desktop and mobile layouts for consistent customer use.
- Added **WordPress** content integration with documented theme and plugin settings, allowing reviewers to update promotional pages without editing application code.
- Converted a 14-page scope document into estimates, acceptance criteria, and two-week milestones, giving a four-person team a practical delivery path.
- Investigated validation, session, and database defects through **browser developer tools** and Laravel logs, recording fixes and regression results for reliable releases.
- Presented **deployment** steps, data-flow diagrams, and security considerations to faculty reviewers, earning a 94% project score.

Supported a faculty-supervised service-request portal and WordPress site through PHP development, database work, testing, documentation, and deployment handoff. Coordinated with student stakeholders and separated front-end and backend work into manageable weekly assignments. Contributions improved usability, traceability, and continuity for future practicum teams.

- Developed **PHP** modules for ticket creation, status updates, and search with MVC conventions and prepared statements, supporting safer data handling.
- Connected **jQuery Ajax** forms with backend endpoints and added validation messages, reducing duplicate submissions during a 20-user classroom usability test.
- Maintained a WordPress site with custom templates, responsive **CSS**, and approved **plugins**, preserving accessible and consistent content presentation.
- Tested static and **dynamic websites** across Chrome, Firefox, and mobile emulation, logging reproducible issues with severity, steps, and expected behavior.
- Reviewed requirements with student stakeholders, divided front-end and backend work, and prepared effort estimates that guided weekly sprint assignments.

Delivered organized code and documentation that gave future contributors a clear base for new features.

- Contributed **Laravel** and **PHP** features for event registration and dynamic program pages backed by a relational database, supporting dependable content delivery.
- Designed tables and CRUD workflows for sessions, speakers, and registrations, then checked edge cases with seeded records and PHPUnit scenarios.
- Built **HTML** and CSS templates with **responsive design** principles, using feedback from 12 student testers to resolve navigation and readability concerns.
- Prototyped a React dashboard consuming JSON endpoints and documented integration boundaries, giving future front-end work a clearer starting point.
