- Cross trained coworkers on equipment checks and support functions, improving readiness across the production line.

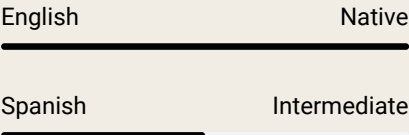
