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SUMMARY

Operates Motor Grader, Asphalt Paver, Bull Dozer, Maintainer, Mixer, Crane Truck, **Rubber Tire Backhoes**, Gradalls, **Front end loader**, Laydown Machine, Linkbelt Boom Mowers, and Reclaimer machine. Performs equipment inspections, field repairs, inventory estimates, daily reports, and emergency response for debris, road hazards, drainage needs, and public requests. Holds a **Texas Class A Commercial Driver's License** and Work Zone Safety Training Certificate. Works safely with limited supervision in changing weather and active public infrastructure areas.

- Completed service **records** and daily reports covering labor, equipment hours, materials, quantities, and unresolved conditions.
- Answered resident questions about work limits and schedules, escalating decisions requiring engineering or supervisory review.
