Dear Hiring Manager,

I am applying for the Junior Frontend Developer - JavaScript position at CedarPoint Digital. I recently completed a Bachelor of Science in Computer Science at Ohio University, where I built responsive interfaces with HTML, CSS, JavaScript, React, and Vue.js. My project work has focused on turning designs into usable pages, testing them across browsers and screen sizes, and improving the details that affect real users.

In my capstone project, I converted 18 Figma screens into reusable React views for a campus event application. I connected event listings to a mock REST API and added loading, empty, and error states so the interface behaved realistically. Before the demonstration, I tested the application in Chrome, Firefox, Safari, and Edge at desktop, tablet, and phone widths, fixing keyboard-navigation and layout issues. I also used Lighthouse and browser performance tools to compress images, defer noncritical scripts, and simplify component rendering.

My other projects strengthened the same practical skills. In a student innovation lab, I translated Sketch mockups into a mobile-first Vue.js scheduling prototype, then used feedback from eight student testers to improve navigation labels, contrast, and small-screen controls. In a hackathon project, I built JavaScript filtering for transit data and resolved overflow and inconsistent button behavior before the final presentation. These experiences taught me to ask clear questions, document implementation decisions, and work constructively with teammates handling design and data.

I would welcome the opportunity to bring that foundation to CedarPoint Digital while continuing to grow through hands-on development and feedback. My portfolio demonstrates the interfaces and implementation choices described above, and I would be glad to discuss how I could contribute to your frontend team.
