- Reworked Protobuf and gRPC contracts across 120 high-use endpoints, adding compatibility rules and **API versioning** controls that protected older iOS and Android releases during staged launches.
- Directed GCP migration with Docker, Kubernetes, **Google Pub/Sub**, and Kafka, pairing lift-and-shift delivery with cloud-native service boundaries and runbooks for safer operations.
- Established Prometheus, OpenTelemetry, Jaeger, and liveprof instrumentation for latency, queue depth, payment failures, and database saturation, speeding diagnosis during member-impacting incidents.
- Shaped credits, subscriptions, and **in-app purchases** with **idempotency** keys, replay-safe event handling, and reconciliation checks across MySQL and asynchronous CPQ queues.
- Led design sessions, complex code reviews, postmortems, and rollout decisions with mobile engineering, QA, Product, and Design using **feature flags** and **A/B testing** controls.

- Built gRPC services with Protobuf contracts and Kafka event pipelines for mobile actions, documenting **failure modes**, **back-pressure**, retries, and idempotent processing for partner teams.
- Implemented Kubernetes deployment patterns through TeamCity and **GitHub Enterprise**, adding health checks, rollback procedures, resource policies, and release verification.
- Expanded PHPUnit unit and functional coverage with **soft-mocks** around payment, subscription, and notification integrations, reducing regression risk during monolith changes.
- Coordinated incident response for backend and monetization issues, tracking postmortem actions and presenting service health, **business metrics**, and rollout results to engineering leadership.

- Modeled subscription renewals, credit grants, refunds, and purchase callbacks with transactional safeguards and idempotent handlers for reliable payment reconciliation.

- Tuned **query plans**, indexes, cache lifetimes, and queue consumers after profiling production bottlenecks, improving consistency across catalog and member activity paths.
- Introduced **PHPUnit** functional suites and peer-review checklists covering schema, migrations, observability, and rollback concerns, strengthening delivery quality across the backend group.
- Partnered with **QA**, mobile developers, **Product**, and Design to validate device behavior end to end, document technical approaches, and monitor feature performance after release.

- Added PHPUnit unit and **functional tests** for account, entitlement, and payment scenarios, improving release confidence across mobile and backend dependencies.
- Used Elasticsearch and query analysis to resolve slow member-search and activity-feed paths, pairing application profiling with index changes and targeted cache invalidation.
- Created deployment and monitoring improvements with **Docker**, **TeamCity**, Prometheus, and operational dashboards, giving engineers clearer rollout and incident signals.
