Dear Hiring Manager,

I am applying for the Python Development Intern position at Brightline Advisory Group. My recent QA automation work has focused on turning repeatable manual checks into dependable Python tests, then giving developers clear evidence when something fails. I am especially interested in this role because Brightline works with language companies, an area that connects directly with my experience testing a university language-learning platform and a mock language-company website.

In my QA Automation Intern role at the University Software Quality Lab, I built and maintained 34 Python and pytest checks for authentication, lesson navigation, account settings, and subscription workflows. I used Selenium fixtures and page objects for browser coverage, requests and SQL for API and PostgreSQL validation, and Jira to document defects with logs, screenshots, reproduction steps, and severity recommendations. During sprint reviews, I presented coverage gaps and failed-test evidence to developers and the product owner, which helped the team focus on defects that affected real user workflows.

My capstone project gave me additional practice designing automation rather than simply writing isolated tests. I created 52 Selenium scenarios with parameterized data, added REST checks for timeout and authorization behavior, and connected execution to GitHub Actions so results were easy to review. I also compared automated results with manual tests and used defect-seeding exercises to find missed cases and false positives. That experience taught me to automate stable, valuable checks while keeping exploratory testing where human judgment is more useful.

I would bring a careful approach to requirements review, defect investigation, and collaboration with QA, development, and product stakeholders. I am available Monday through Friday from 9 AM to 6 PM Eastern Time and can work outside those hours when needed. My English proficiency is C1 on the CEFR scale. Thank you for considering my application; I would welcome the opportunity to discuss how I could contribute to your automation work.
