Faculty supervised capstone focused on safe perioperative transitions for simulated adult surgical cases. Work covered care **planning**, verification, intraoperative priorities, handoff communication, infection prevention, and evidence based presentation.

- Mapped perioperative transitions for simulated adult cases using **assessment**, verification, handoff, and **evaluation** steps.
- Applied nursing process across 12 scenarios, documenting diagnoses, interventions, implementation steps, and evaluation criteria.
- Practiced sterile field awareness, **surgical counts**, positioning principles, **specimen handling**, and circulating communication.
- Built preoperative checklist covering identity, procedure, consent, allergies, history, and required documentation.
- Reviewed **infection prevention** evidence and presented practical surgical safety findings to 18 classmates.
- Revised escalation and handoff protocol after simulation debriefings identified communication and workflow gaps.

Operating Room Nursing Simulation

Supervised simulation experience introducing operating room workflows for **circulating** and **scrub** roles across several surgical specialties. Repeated competency stations developed room preparation, sterile practice, assessment, SBAR communication, charting, patient advocacy, and response to feedback.

- Completed supervised simulations for **general surgery**, orthopedics, gynecology, and urology **operating room** scenarios.
- Prepared rooms with preference information, supply lists, and safety checks before simulated patient arrival.
- Recognized contamination events during timed scenarios and initiated corrective actions under instructor observation.
- Conducted simulated assessments and interviews, then communicated findings through **SBAR** to surgical team peers.
- Documented events, counts, positioning checks, and handoff details in perioperative training records.
- Applied preceptor feedback to improve sequencing, communication, situational awareness, and **patient advocacy**.

Perioperative Patient Safety Research Project

Academic research project examined preventable perioperative safety events and translated published evidence into practical nursing actions. Work supported transparent review, interdisciplinary communication, patient identification, infection prevention, positioning, and safe transitions within supervised practice.

- Examined evidence on **patient identification**, communication, **infection prevention**, positioning, and transitions of care.
- Compared 20 peer reviewed sources by study design, setting, intervention, and reported safety outcome.
- Translated findings into nursing actions aligned with **assessment**, planning, implementation, and **evaluation**.
- Created poster showing how verification and standardized communication support safer surgical workflows.
- Presented **research** to a nursing seminar and answered faculty questions about evidence limitations.
