- Reworked checkout state transitions and **GraphQL** loading across cart, promotion, and fulfillment flows, reducing inconsistent order summaries and clarifying release acceptance decisions.
- Designed **Node.js** services and RESTful integrations for inventory and customer profiles, using schema validation and secure service boundaries across AWS workloads.
- Diagnosed peak-season listing delays through tracing and query plans, refining **PostgreSQL** indexes and **MongoDB** access patterns without disrupting customer workflows.
- Established Mocha and JUnit testing conventions with API contract coverage, improving pull-request readiness and release confidence within Scrum delivery.
- Led architecture reviews, code reviews, and performance retrospectives for six engineers, translating technical tradeoffs for design, QA, merchandising, and operations partners.

- Delivered React and **Next.js** catalog search, product detail, and account experiences across eight storefronts, using hooks, **Context**, and modular CSS for consistent behavior.
- Implemented **event-driven** Node.js services that synchronized pricing and availability through RESTful and GraphQL endpoints, adding retry handling for intermittent partner responses.
- Modeled **PostgreSQL** transaction workflows for saved carts and MongoDB documents for browsing preferences, giving QA and support teams clear schema and query documentation.
- Containerized local and test environments with **Docker** and supported **Kubernetes** deployment manifests, helping engineers reproduce integration defects before sprint demonstrations.

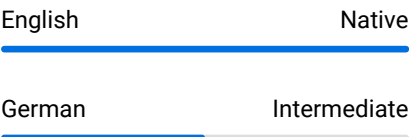
